



RV & Caravan Sites

As the site plan for the RV & Caravan area has been developed, a variety of questions have been raised. The following information is provided to assist members who are attending the 2013 Fraser Coast AGM Event.

For simplicity, the information is presented as questions and answers.

1. How big are the RV/Caravan sites?

9 metres x 6 metres.

2. My fifth-wheeler won't fit on a 9x6 site. What should I do?

3. What facilities do the RV/Caravan sites have?

RV/Caravan sites are provided with 15 Amp electrical outlets, fresh water taps & grey water pits. It is suggested that all RV/Caravan owners come prepared with appropriate hoses and electrical leads, as all connection points are central to multiple sites.

4. My RV/Caravan has a toilet cassette system that must be emptied every couple of days. Are there facilities on site to do that?

Yes. There are two dump points on site; One is beside the main campground amenities block, which is no more than 250 m from any RV site. The other is in the car-park at the Check-In Hall.

5. Can I drive my vehicle in and out of the RV/Caravan area?

No. Once your RV or Caravan has been parked, any vehicles (other than bikes) that need to move in and out of the grounds should be parked in the separate area provided for towing vehicles. This area is within sight and about 150 metres from the RV/Caravan area. It is still within the fenced showgrounds complex, and a 24/7 security service will be checking site entries at the adjacent campground gate.

6. My RV is my only transport at the AGM. If I'm not allowed to drive it in and out of the grounds, what should I do?

7. Are there any exceptions to Point# 6?

Yes. Members who have been issued with a 2013 AGM Event "Disabled Vehicle Permit"

8. What if I ride my bike to the AGM, and want to pitch my tent in the RV/Caravan area?

This is definitely not recommended. The surface in the RV area consists entirely of rough ironstone and bitumen. These sites are also more expensive than standard grassed sites.

9. Can I park my RV at the showgrounds site a couple of weeks before the event opens?

No; Because the showgrounds is in constant use by other events, no entry will be allowed.

Note: From Monday 8th to Sunday 14th April 2013 inclusive, members who have submitted a 2013 Event Volunteer Form and have received notification that they are rostered to assist with setup will be allowed to camp at the grounds beginning the day before their first shift. If the setup week rosters are full, members who just “turn up” during setup week will not be allowed entry until the event opens at 7am on Monday 15th April 2013.

10. What’s the best time to check-in and check-out with my RV/Caravan?

RV check-in is Monday 15th April 2013 and check-out is Sunday 21st April 2013. If you are delayed through unforeseen circumstances, it will still be possible to enter the site & park your RV. This process may take time however, so your patience will be appreciated.

11. I’m going to attend the CMCA rally which opens at the showgrounds only one week after the Ulysses AGM Event closes. Can I remain at my site until the CMCA event opens?

No; Because of contractual and liability reasons, you must leave the showgrounds to allow venue sign-off by Ulysses, and sign-on by the CMCA.
