Fraser Island Explorer 4WD Tour

A visit to the world's largest sand island is a "must do" for everyone. To truly appreciate the remarkable natural beauty of Fraser Island, you must experience it first hand. Words cannot really capture the emotion of seeing the stark contrast of talc-like white sand and blue-green window lakes, the ancient dignity of the towering rainforests growing in seemingly infertile sands, the purity of the water flowing in its many creeks ... it is possible to go on and on, just like the seemingly endless beaches.
